

Social Development Partnership Program Supporting Black Canadian Communities Grant

▪ **Deadline: July 27, 2020 at 3:00pm (EDT)**

The Supporting Black Canadian Communities Grant aims to help Black -led organizations in Canada fulfill their missions and better serve Canadian black communities. The grant supports projects and provides capital assistance to celebrate, share knowledge and build capacity in Canada's vibrant Black Canadian communities.

Focus Areas

Black-led organizations to submit proposals of up to \$100,000 for capital projects such as:

- purchasing work-related equipment; and/or
- undertaking renovations and retrofits of existing community and work spaces to improve their functionality.

Funding: Not-for-Profit organizations that are Black led, can apply for up to \$100,000 in funding.

Eligible organizations:

- Are Black-led organizations (minimum of two-thirds of the leadership positions/ governance structure is composed of people who self-identify as Black)
- Have a mandate that is Black-focused
- Are a legal entity in Canada
- Are not-for-profit organizations

Eligible Projects:

- Must be for equipment purchases for work or community spaces
 - computers or tablets
 - desks or work furniture
 - software
 - telephone systems
 - boardroom tables
 - sound systems
 - smart boards



- kitchen appliances
- equipment to facilitate working virtually
- Renovations or retrofits of existing workspaces or community spaces that you own or lease to improve their functionality.
 - painting an office or community meeting room
 - increasing office space or improving lay-out
 - renovating or commercializing community kitchens to meet local fire and building codes, by-Laws,
 - modernizing community program spaces such as gyms
 - updating outdoor play spaces to meet current safety standards, etc.

Activities that are not eligible:

- Retrofit of motor vehicles used for community-based transportation, for example:
 - automobiles
 - vans
 - buses
- Construction, renovation and retrofit of private homes or dwellings
- Construction, renovation and retrofit activities related to the embellishment/or esthetics of a building or its surroundings

Project Time: Should be completed in approximately 12 months.
